Job Title: Production & Facilities Leader

Direct Supervisor: Executive Director of Operations

Average Hours/Week: Full Time (40+ hours)

General Vision

The Production & Facility Leader provides oversight to the production team & facility volunteers while working closely with the worship leaders and teams, church staff and other ministries to ensure gatherings and events are technologically enhanced and free from distractions. This position is also responsible for the general oversight of the buildings, grounds, equipment, AVL equipment, mechanical systems, cleaning, and ensuring the facilities are operational, safe, clean, and ready for church services and other ministry activities.

Essential Job Functions | Production

- Manage AVL systems across Veritas campuses: Set-up & tear-down of video, lighting and audio elements for Veritas services and events.
- Recruit, manage, train, and schedule production volunteers for all Veritas services and events (including, but not limited to, Sundays, Students, Salt Co., leader gatherings, etc.)
- Maintain AVL equipment, troubleshoot problems, and oversee repairs of older equipment and purchasing of new equipment
- Identify and implement new technologies and tools, as needed, under the direction of the Operations Director.
- Attend, serve, and lead at all required events and activities including staff meetings, devotionals, special events, staff development days, etc.
- Oversee and manage the production budget
- Work closely with and serve worship leaders and teams

Essential Job Functions | Facility

• Building Security: Ensuring the proper building doors and access points are open and closed for and after scheduled events.

- Facility/Event Schedule: Using the facility schedule, assist ministries in executing room set ups for events, including tables and chair configurations as well as specific ministry needs.
- Cleaning: Using the facility schedule, work with the contracted cleaning service to ensure the building is clean and operationally ready for day to day events and weekend services.
- Room Management: Inspecting rooms prior to events and connecting with the
 event leader prior to the event to make sure all facility needs are met, including
 temperature settings, doors and access, room configurations, and last minute needs
 and details.
- Building Systems: Ensure building systems such as HVAC, doors, and lighting are operational.
- Vendors: Be the primary point of contact for building and maintenance vendors
- Volunteers: Identify, develop, and schedule a team of facility volunteers to assist in building and maintenance repairs.
- Customer Service: Incorporate with all staff and volunteers a customer service-oriented approach when dealing with church staff, volunteers, vendors, and participants of Veritas.

- Communication Demonstrated capacity to instruct, and encourage through effective communication in various settings. Able to communicate and work within a complex organizational structure with multiple layers of input.
- Collaborative Leadership Skills - Collaborate across the organization and with various ministry departments. Ability to lead in concert with other leaders. Able to successfully develop new and better ways to work and promote a continuous improvement mentality.
